She completed her residency in internal medicine at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, New York. Dr. Karippot then served as chief fellow while completing a fellowship in hematology and oncology at Seton Hall University in New Jersey.

Dr. Karippot is a member of several organizations, including the American Society of Hematology, the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) and has authored several articles in peer-reviewed journals and presented her work at national conferences. Her leadership roles include Chair of the Commission on Cancer committee and as a member of the medical executive committee. Dr Vinod A. Pullarkat is Professor of Hematology and Hematopoietic Cell Transplantation at City of Hope. He completed residency in internal medicine at New York Methodist Hospital and subsequently underwent fellowship training in Hematology/Oncology at University of Southern California (USC). He then held a fellowship in bone marrow transplantation at the City of Hope Medical Center in Duarte, CA, and continued to serve as faculty from 2003-2010 before moving back to USC to serve as Medical Director of the Bone Marrow Transplantation Program. He returned to City of Hope in 2014.

Dr. Pullarkat is focused on researching the treatment of acute leukemia, stem cell transplantation, bone marrow failure, and autoimmune hematologic disorders. His basic research centers around developing new drugs for acute leukemia. Dr. Pullarkat is recognized as a global leader in the treatment of B Lymphoblastic Leukemias. He has authored over 200 scientific articles in various peer-reviewed journals and edited books on acute leukemia. Additionally, he serves as the principal investigator for multiple clinical trials at City of Hope.
